This could be caused by a setting in the printer driver. If your printer does not have a cutter or peeler, you must make sure that the cutter and peeler options are not enabled. To do this, follow the instructions below.

- 1. Right click on the Wasp printer in the Printers folder.
- 2. On the General tab, click on Printing Preferences.
- 3. Click on the Advanced tab and make sure that the media says without cutter or peeler.

- 4. Click OK. Click Apply if changes were made.
- 5. On the main printer properties window, click on the Advanced tab.
- 6. Click on the Printing Defaults button.
- 7. Check here to make sure that media is set to without cutter or peeler.
- 8. Click OK. Click Apply if changes were made.

Try printing a Windows test page. If you do have a cutter and/or peeler, make sure that the media settings are set to the appropriate option.
