Several WPL printer models are equipped with a USB port where a barcode scanner or keyboard can be connected, including:

After some initial setup, this feature allows you to create and print a barcode label without the use of a computer or labeling software. Create and print a barcode by simply typing the desired content on your USB connected keyboard, or scan an existing barcode to create and print a copy.
