

How do I create a label in Labeler v6 with a barcode or text field whose value increases or decrease with each label printed?

In Wasp Labeler v6, a value that increases or decreases with each label printed is called a serialized value.

To create a label with a numeric text field that increases by 1 with each label printed:

1. Create a text box on a new label.
2. Right click on the text box created above and choose "Source".
3. Click on Serialization/Numeric, then click Next.
4. Make sure that Incrementing Series is selected, and put your starting number into Start At Seed.
5. Click OK.

To create a label with a numeric text field that decreases by 1 with each label printed.

1. Create a text box on a new label.
2. Right click on the text box created above and choose "Source".
3. Click on Serialization/Numeric, then click Next.
4. Make sure that Decrementing Series is selected, and put your starting number into Start At Seed.
5. Click OK.
