## How to restore a blank database from WaspTime 7

This article covers restoring WaspTime 7 to a blank database from the WaspTime application. Follow these instructions to erase all data and start over.

## 1. Download the blank label

http://dl.waspbarcode.com/wasp/supportfiles/WaspTime7\_blank.zip

2. Unzip and place the backup file in this default location:

C:\Program Files (x86)\Microsoft SQL Server\MSSQL.1\MSSQL\Backup



3. From WaspTime Go to **Tools** > **Database Restore** > Enter the name of the blank backup file. **WaspTime7\_blank.bkp** and click **Restore**
