Question: Is there a way to program the WDT60 or WDT90 to edit the data contained in a barcode? For example, ignore a leading character in a shipping barcode, like Q for quantity or S for serial number, or send only specific characters in the data.

Answer: No, those mobile devices do not have data editing. (Though some attributes of some symbologies can be enabled and disabled. For example, discard the system or check digit of UPC-A.)

Wasp's model HC1 mobile device has data editing capabilities to perform certain data transformations.
