Juniper Systems has developed a utility intended to help get Windows Mobile Device Center working on Windows 10.

Instructions:

1. Set WMDC to run in Windows Vista Compatibility Mode.
 - a. In Windows File Explorer, find C:\Windows\WindowsMobile\wmhc.exe.
 - b. Right-click it, Properties.
 - c. Compatibility tab.
 - d. "Change settings for all users" button. Authenticate if necessary.
 - e. Check box "Run this program in compatibility mode for", Windows Vista.
 - f. OK, OK.
2. Right-click WMDC-Helper.exe and Run As Administrator.
3. Reboot the PC.

Note: Depending on the situation and error messages, other subsequent troubleshooting steps may be necessary.
