Once the order has been picked, it will send the order details back to your e-commerce store. This integration is an add-on feature for your InventoryCloud. 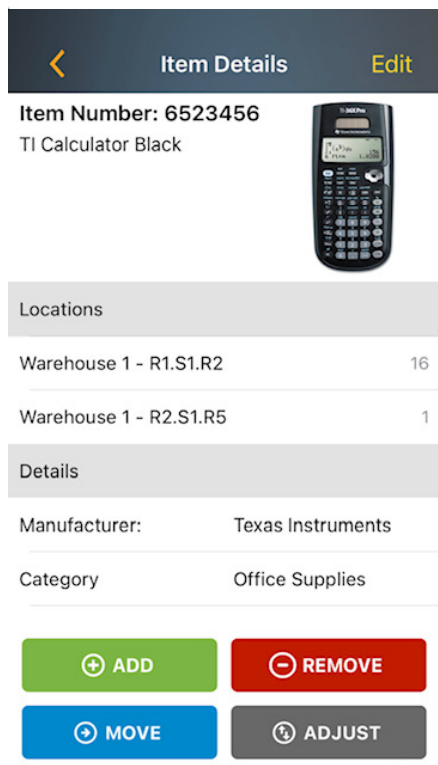
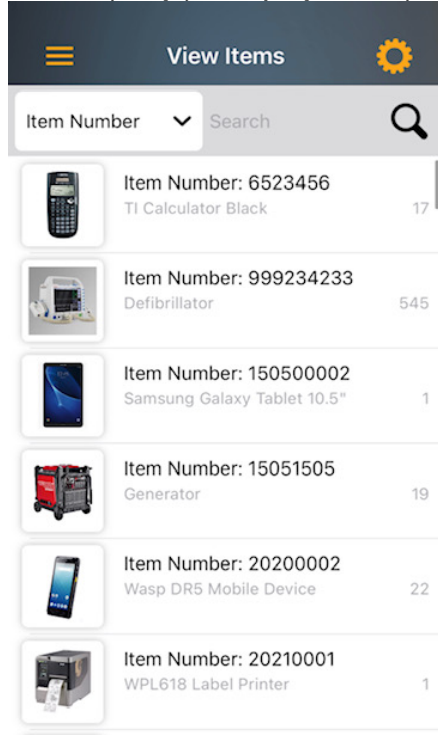

("All" will allow you to search any of these as well as a description of the item.) If you click a single item from the search page, it will bring up the new item details page. The item details page will show you information about the item, each location that contains quantity, and transaction performance buttons at the bottom. The locations can be clicked to see tracking details at each location if you use trackbys.

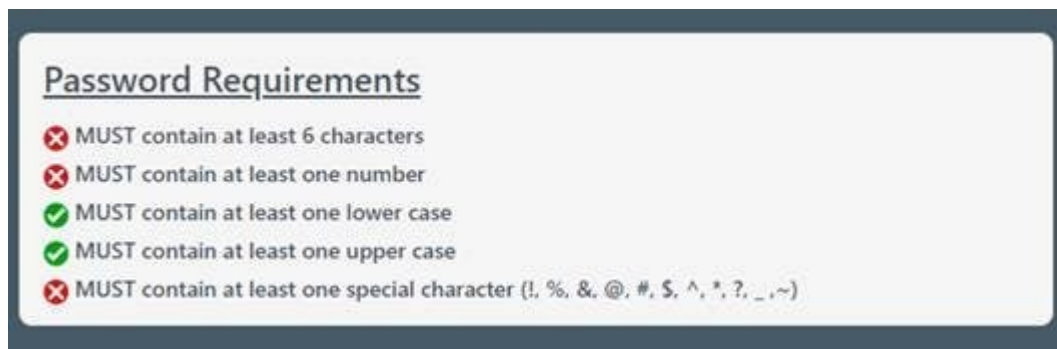
